# Why?

### ACCESS

- provides access to research outputs
- place for digital heritage

#### PROMOTE

- provides a shop window for people interested in what the institution has to offer (openoasis.org)

#### PRESERVE



# Why?

### Can be used as a CRIS (at certain extent)

#### MONITORING

- research monitoring and assessment
- open access statistics
- monitoring research output by funders

# **INPUT** hard part!

- Can take **years** to establish
- Policies, processes, practices
- Education of researchers and staff
- Carrot and stick
- "If you do not submit your article, then..."

# OUTPUT

Established routines

Can be set up in couple of hours



Who is responsible of the repository software? Who is responsible of the server maintenance? Where one can find support for batch uploads? Support for development?

What kind of material is saved? Who is responsible of the quality of metadata? Who will produce reports of research output? How scientific articles are submitted? Who controls user permissions? How about master's theses? Is research data allowed?
