The case of district heating in the Helsinki Metropolitan area


OUR TASK

SMRs are seen as one option for district heating in the Helsinki metropolitan area.

We analyse residents' views on:

- 1) SMR-based district heating, and
- 2) public participation, and decision-making on an SMR project.


SMRs are...

Opposed by women, those in the age group of 30-39 years, as well as the supporters of the Green League and the Left Alliance

Supported most often by men, those over 70 years of age, as well as the supporters of the Finns Party, the National Coalition Party, and the Finnish Social Democratic Party

OPPONENTS OF SMRs

Opponents are more unwilling to delegate decision-making on an SMR project to the city council, than the supporters. Almost 70% of the opponents agree with the need for a consultative referendum.

Almost one in three opponents would participate in a protest against an SMR project.



SUPPORTERS OF SMRs

Less than 50% of the supporters agree on the need for a municipal consultative referendum, and more than 25% are against it.

Supporters are more inclined to delegate the decision-making power to the city council.

CONCLUSIONS

Almost half (46%) of the respondents in the Helsinki Metropolitan would accept an SMR in their municipality of residence.

When asked for residents' preference for district heating options, SMRs are among the most disliked types of production.

The majority of the respondents agreed that the residents must be informed (88%) and have an opportunity to participate in collaborative planning (71%) of a possible SMR project.

The principle of granting a veto right to the city council gained strong support, even though the supporters and oppontents of SMRs held diverging views on the overall role of the city council in decision-making on SMRs.

Planning of a possible SMR project should begin early - and adopt a collaborative and participative style.
