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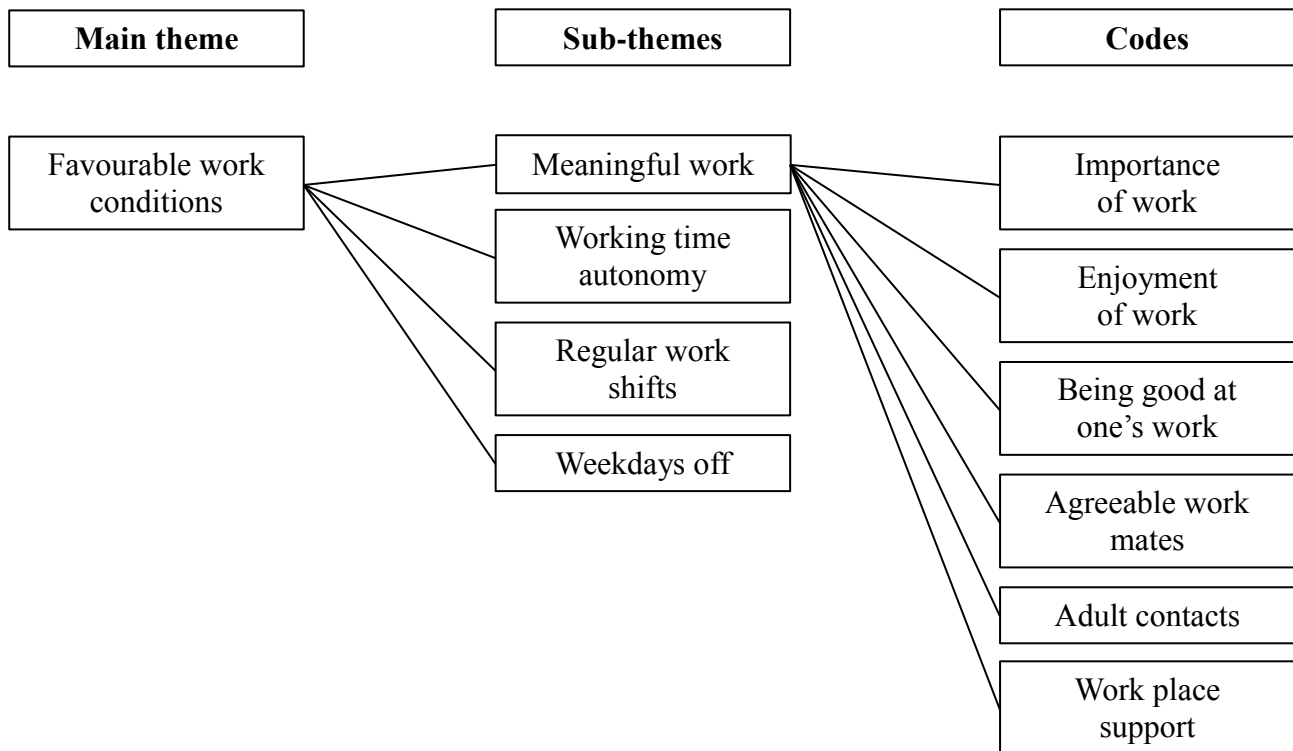
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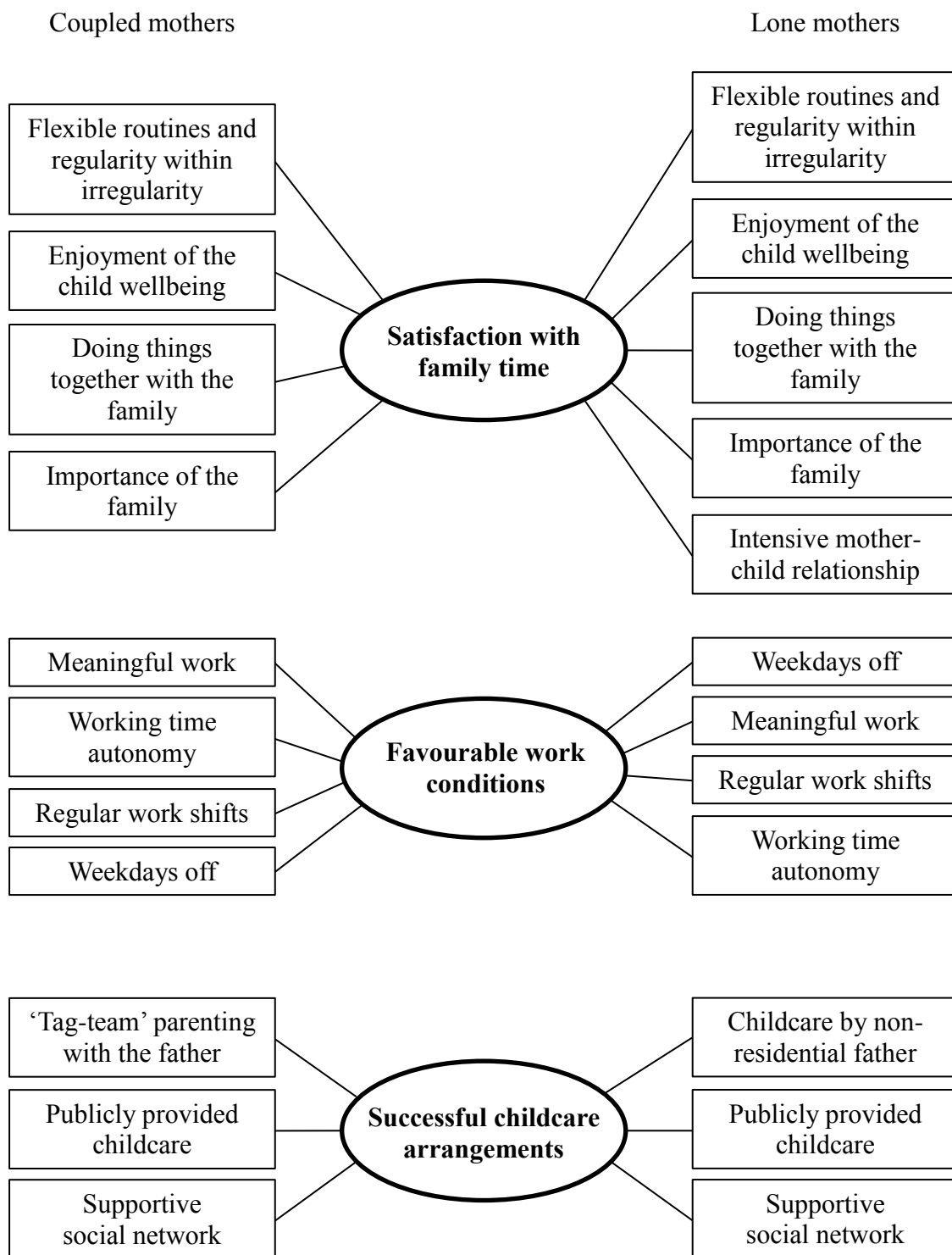
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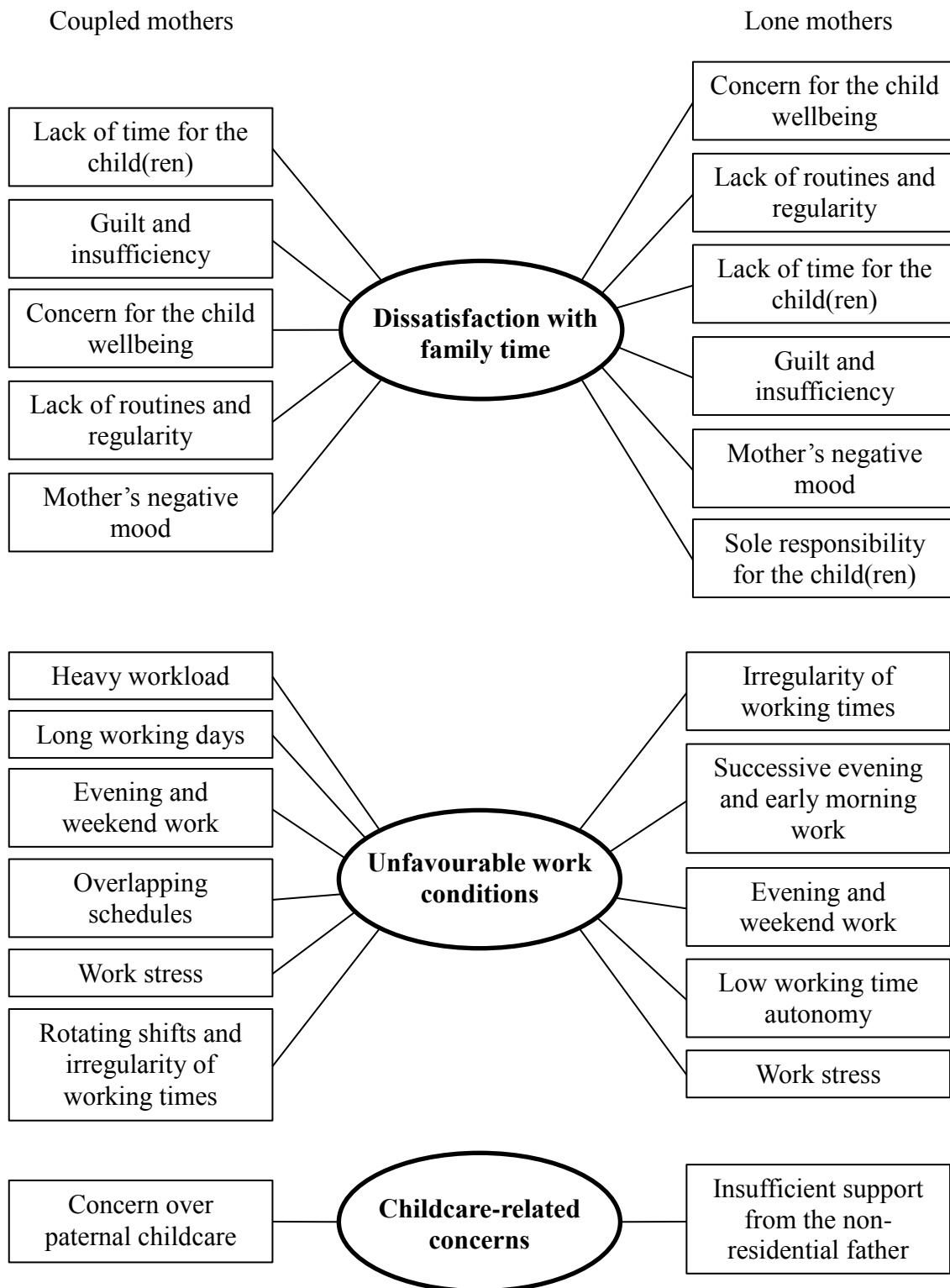
**Figure 1.** Example of the generation of the main theme ‘favourable work conditions, its sub-themes, and the codes of the first sub-theme ‘meaningful work’
