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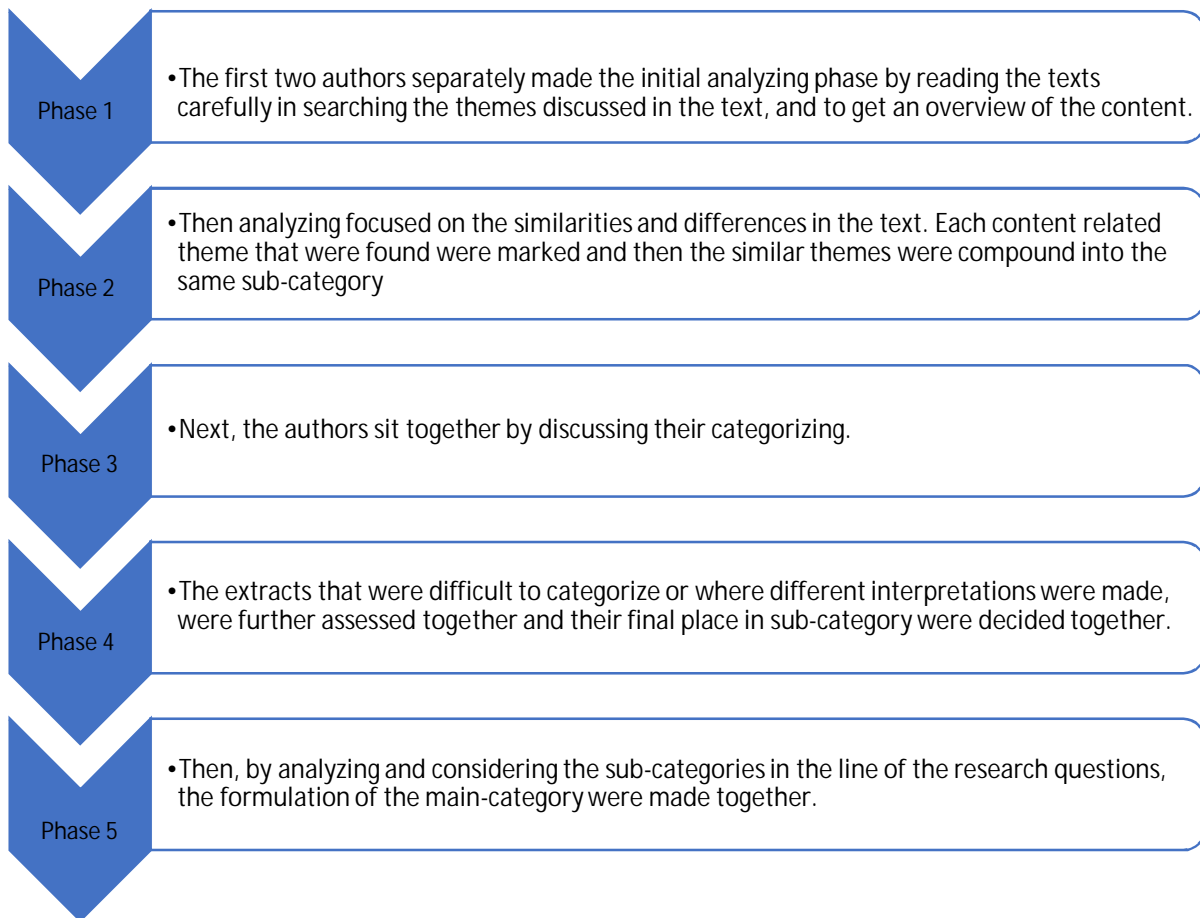





Figure 1. The five steps of qualitative content analysis, adapted from Graneheim&Lundman (2014)

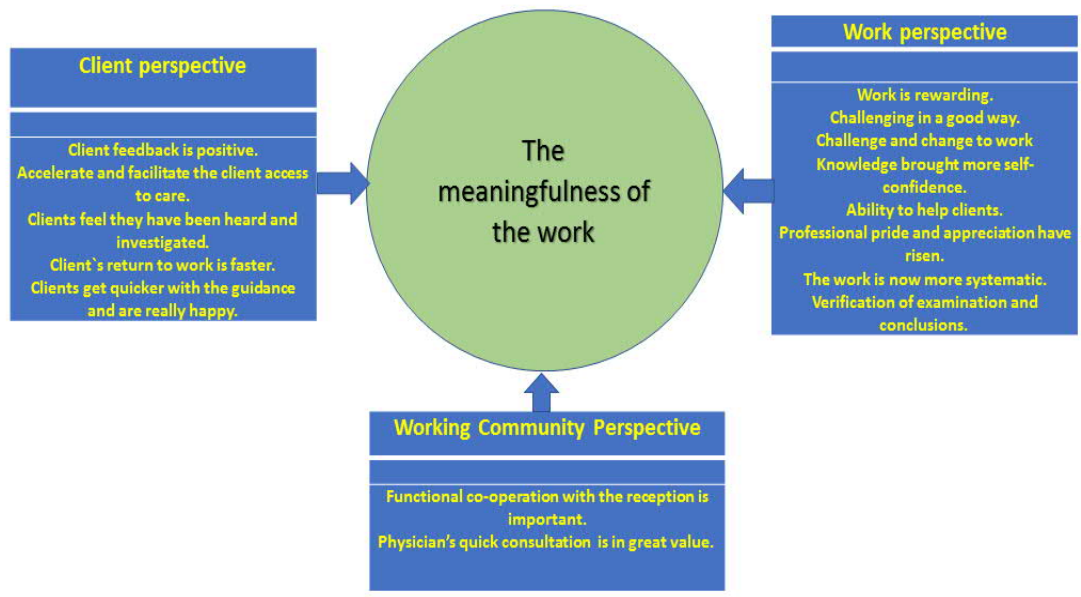


Figure 3. Summarised results about physiotherapists' experiences of their direct access practice
